Find out what you can about this animal and use the information to write a fact sheet.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Write an information report about the animal, including paragraphs, subheadings, labelled diagrams and fascinating facts.</p>	<p>2. Write a sentence for each of your spelling words this week.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Find as many words as you can which follow the same spelling rule. Make a list in your book.</p>	<p>3. "My brother always gets the bigger half," moaned Greg. Is this possible? Explain your reasoning.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> A third (<math>\frac{1}{3}</math>) is bigger than a half (<math>\frac{1}{2}</math>). True or false? Explain your reasoning and draw a picture to prove it.</p>	<p>4. Pick a number between 1 and 10. Double it. Describe how you can double it in four different ways. e.g. <math>4+4=8</math> <math>4 \times 2=8</math> 2 lots of 4 is 8 Double 4 is 8 Repeat with 4 different numbers.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Keep doubling your answer until it is three digits. Record what you did.</p>	<p>5. Make a model of a boat. This might be a sailing dinghy, barge, canoe, tanker or any other boat you might find on a river.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> With an adult, take your boat to a nearby stream or river and see if it floats! Don't forget to take a picture.</p>
<p>6. Toad is having a party at Toad hall. Create an invitation inviting people to come. Don't forget to include the date and time!</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Pretend that you went to the party and write a letter to Toad saying 'thank you'. Describe the parts of the party that you enjoyed the most and say why.</p>	<p>7. Get an adult to choose two random numbers between 0 and 20. Use the more than and less than symbols. &lt; less than &gt; more than e.g. <math>12 &lt; 15</math> Repeat 5 times.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Repeat the above but for numbers between 20 and 100.</p>	<p>8. Draw or paint a picture of a river scene. You could use water colours or any medium you choose.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Include some of the features of a river in your picture.</p>	<p>9. Make a model or draw a picture of one of the characters from The Wind in the Willows.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Write a paragraph about the character explaining everything you know about them.</p>	<p>10. Using a tape measure, measure the height of your family members and record the measurements in your book.</p> <p><b>Challenge</b> Help a family member bake a meal and practise measuring different amounts of ingredients. Record your measurements and take photographs of the meal for your books.</p>
