That progress of all PP children and forces children in reception, Year 1 and 2 is equal to or above that of non-PP children	To part fund TA support in the Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 class. (With only 13 children in the class numbers would not normally justify a full-time TA in the mornings. However with PP needs in this class and three diverse curriculums, TA support is part-funded from PP money.)	£4795
To accelerate progress of children who join the school within the year who are working below expected levels to close the gap between them and their peers	To continue to fund additional TA hours for small group intervention programs for spelling, phonics and maths for PP children who joined the school in year and are working below expectations for year group. Specific interventions are needed to support those disadvantaged children that struggle to succeed academically. Specific TAs use interventions and post teaching sessions to ensure individual progress and to help target children to feel more involved and to have better understanding of concepts.	£4795
To support disadvantaged children with SEMH issues. This will help to prevent barriers to learning and to improve positive attitudes towards school life	Fund hours for an Emotional Literacy Support Assistant (ELSA) in order that additional support is available to support vulnerable pupils. The ELSA has timetabled hours to support children in class and to bring them out for a short period of time if necessary to provide regular emotional support so that they can re-engage and gradually develop healthier emotions.	£2750
