

LITERACY

Class Read: The Girl who Speaks Bear by Sophie Anderson. This is an adventure about a girl called Yanka who goes on a journey of self discovery. Our writing purpose this term will be writing to entertain with a focus on setting description and narrative. Our first text will be Varmints and we will use this to write a positive and negative setting description. We will then use Paperman, the awarding winning film by Disney, to inspire our narrative writing.

SCIENCE

As scientists we will learn that:

- materials have different uses depending on their properties and state (liquid, solid, gas).
- properties include hardness, transparency, electrical and thermal conductivity and attraction to magnets.
- some materials will dissolve in a liquid and form a solution while others are insoluble and form sediment.
- mixtures can be separated by filtering, sieving and evaporation.
- some changes to materials are reversible (such as dissolving, mixing and changes of state).
- some changes result in the formation of new materials and these are not reversible (such as burning wood or rusting)

ART

Our focus this term will be drawing and painting. With the help of Devizes Museum, we will discover the artist Eric Ravilious, who used the Wiltshire landscape as the inspiration for many of his paintings.

GEOGRAPHY

As geographers this term, we will study our local area of Wiltshire and its surrounding counties. We will find out about the jobs and lifestyles of its people. Through fieldwork we will make map of the school grounds. We will then plot photographs of local area on to map, using coordinates and finally create a guidebook.
