

Maths

This term we will be building our knowledge of place value and addition and subtraction.

We will also be focusing on our times tables by practising these regularly. The challenge is to learn all tables up to x12 by the end of Year 4!

Science

Chough Class has been assigned a mission to create its own museum collection of rocks and fossils. We will be working scientifically to explore and explain the differences between rocks and soil, and to understand the importance of fossils and palaeontology in providing evidence about the past.

Literacy

In Literacy we will be writing a narrative based on the Incredible Book Eating Boy by Oliver Jeffers and a non-chronological report based on The Street Beneath My Feet Charlotte Guillain and Yuval Zommer.

We will be practising handwriting and spellings on a daily basis in school.

Topic

In geography we will be exploring the wonderful sights to be found right on our doorstep. We will be using mapping skills to locate and plot places of interest and exploring the demographics in different locations to help us produce our own guidebook.

Our Christianity focus will explore what Christians learn from the creation story and how this connects with modern day science.

PE

PSHE
