This term we will continue to build our fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills to deepen our understanding of addition and subtraction; before moving onto multiplication and division. Times tables remain a focus with daily practise to make progress in our whole school Marvellous Maths challenge.

## Science

In Biology, Chough Class will be looking at Animals, including Humans. We will work scientifically to learn about teeth, the digestive system and the importance of food chains in our natural habitats.

## English

We will be learning how to write a set of instructions using imperative verbs and time conjunctions based on the story How to Wash Your Woolly Mammoth (M. Robinson & K. Hindley). We will then go on an adventure with The Stone Age Boy (S. Kitamura) for our fictional writing.

We will have daily handwriting and spelling practice school.
