TUDOR KINGS AND QUEENS

The Tudors were a Welsh-English family that ruled England and Wales from 1485 to 1603 (118 years).

In 1485 The Battle of Bosworth was fought between King Richard III and Henry Tudor. Richard was killed, so Henry became King Henry VII. His son Henry became King Henry VIII in 1509.

Queen Elizabeth I did not have children, so there was no heir to the throne when she died. This marked the end of the Tudor Era.
