

Maths

This term we will continue to build our fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills to deepen our understanding of fractions.

Times tables remain a focus. Please encourage your child to practise regularly – by chanting, using TT RockStars or for a speed test visit <https://www.timestables.co.uk/multiplication-tables-check/>

Science

In Biology, Chough Class we be learning about Living things and their habitats. We will learn how to classify groups in different ways, explore living things in our area and think about the impact of human and natural disturbances on the environment.

DT

We will be learning new techniques to join two pieces together to make a longer piece and how to join corners. We will make a mood board of kite designs, before designing our own – thinking about our joining knowledge. Finally, we will build our own kites before flying them...

Geography

Using maps, we will be identifying areas in the world which are affected by extreme weather and natural disasters. We will explore the causes of different natural disasters and the affect they have on people's lives and the environment.
