



Answer questions such as 'What is your favourite book?' and 'What do you like about it?'

Mark making for different contexts around the classroom.

Phase 2 phonics—single letter sounds.

Beginning to write single letters with mostly correct formation.



Phase 3 phonics – digraphs.

Beginning to write for a purpose around the classroom.

Use words and phrases from texts in context and explain what they mean.

Using correct letter formation to write words.



Say a sentence aloud in preparation for writing. Segment Phase 2 and 3 sounds for spelling.

 Beginning to know some Phase 5 digraphs

Begin to answer retrieval, prediction and inference questions.
